



**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTIONS 14(2)**

**TEMPORARY 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT, ONE-WAY TRAFFIC FLOW & PROHIBITION OF WAITING & LOADING –  
VARIOUS ROADS, STRATFORD UPON AVON**

**Warwickshire County Council hereby imposes a 20 mph speed limit upon the entire lengths of the roads described below which are all situate within Stratford upon Avon, for a period of 21 days commencing on 15 June 2020:-**

Bridge Street	Mansell Street	College Mews	Chapel Lane
Wood Street	Church Street	Holtom Street	Scholars Lane
Union Street	Windsor Street	Ryland Street	Chestnut Walk
Waterside	Greenhill Street	Saffron Meadow	New Street

High Street	West Street	Henley Street	Broad Street
Chapel Street	Sanctus Street	Sheep Street	Evesham Place

**Warwickshire County Council hereby further imposes One-Way traffic flows (with mandatory contra flow cycle lanes) upon the lengths of roads described below which are all situate within Stratford upon Avon, in the direction as specified , for a period of 21 days commencing 15 June 2020:**


Bridge Street	One-way westbound only along its entire length.
Rother Street	One-way southbound only along its entire length.
Wood Street	One-way westbound only along its entire length.
Greenhill Street	One-way westbound only along its entire length. (For the duration of this Notice The Warwickshire County Council (Greenhill Street/Arden Street) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2003 is hereby temporarily suspended).
High Street/Chapel Street/Church Street	One-way southbound only along its entire length.
Alcester Road	One-way westbound only, between its junctions with Brunel Way and Arden Street.
Sheep Street	One-way westbound only, from its junction with Waterside for a distance of 114 metres.
Diversion routes for traffic affected by the One Way traffic flows:	Chestnut Walk, A4390 Grove Road, Arden Street, A3400 Birmingham Road following on to the One-Way system round to Bridge Foot.

**Warwickshire County Council further hereby prohibits the waiting of any vehicle (including for the purposes of loading or unloading except where the Council has given prior express permission) upon the lengths of roads described below which are all situate within Stratford upon Avon, for a period of 21 days commencing on 15 June 2020:-**

Sheep Street	on its northern side along its entire length.
Bridge Street	on both sides along its entire length (including the suspension of Bus Stops)
High Street	on both sides along its entire length.
Chapel Street	on its western side along its entire length.
Exemptions:	Exemptions will apply to vehicles being used by the emergency services, by local authorities or by statutory undertakers to undertake urgent works in the roads and to Blue Badge Holders where express permission is given to wait by the Council.
Reason for Notice:	The above measures are required because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the Coronavirus Pandemic to enable social distancing measures to be implemented.

**Notice Effective from:** 15 June 2020 for a period of 21 days and then it is anticipated that the restrictions will be continued by a Temporary Traffic Order pursuant to sections 14(1) and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for a maximum combined duration of 18 months.
