# STRATFORD UPON AVON TOWN COUNCIL, REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY 14 NOVEMBER 2021

#### INTRODUCTION

Stratford upon Avon Town Council is responsible for organising Stratford's Act of Commemoration on Remembrance Sunday.

A road closure [RCO 27] is in place to ensure the safety of those participating in the procession and members of the public who may assemble on the highway outside the Remembrance Garden.

The Civic Procession starts (1035hrs) from the Town Hall in Sheep Street along Chapel Street, Church Street into Old Town directly to the Remembrance Garden.

Following the Service of Remembrance, the Civic Party will return to the Town Hall by Old Town, Church Street, and then carry on to Chapel Street after a March Past in Church Street. The Band and the Contingents will return to Bull Street via Southern Lane, Waterside, Chapel lane and Church Street. The Commemoration is then over.

ROADS CLOSED: 0915hrs - 1230hrs

Chapel Street, Chapel Lane, Church Street, Chestnut Walk, Bull Street, Old Town, College Street, Waterside, Southern Lane.

Roads will be opened when it is safe to do so.

The Park & Ride and Stratford-upon-Avon Parkway train station car parks will now operate as one, with the car park being converted to a Pay and Display car park. All users will be required to purchase a car park Pay & Display ticket or have a valid season ticket displayed on their dashboard. This does not apply to Blue Badge holders when displaying a current blue badge.

#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

The Stratford-upon-Avon train station is approximately 10 minutes from the Town Hall and there is an easy pedestrian route with dropped kerbs and tactile paving at all major road junctions.

Due to the "**UPMARKET**" located in Bridge Street town centre buses for Wood Street and Bridge Street are diverted to Guild Street "**MOP STOPS**" on both sides of the road at the rear of Marks and Spencer and adjacent to Kwik Fit.

#### **BLUE BADGE PARKING ON STREET**

Spaces that are affected by the road closures are as follows:

Bridge Street – 3 blue badge spaces

Chapel Lane – 7 blue badge spaces

Waterside – 10 blue badge spaces

Church Street – 1 blue badge space

#### **BLUE BADGE PARKING IN CAR PARKS**

Arden Street - 3 blue badge spaces

Bridgeway Multi-storey - 13 blue badge spaces

Church Street - 2 blue badge spaces (restricted access between 0915-1300hrs)

Guild Street (rear of the Library) - 3 blue badge spaces

Leisure Centre – 7 blue badge spaces

Recreation Ground – 8 blue badge spaces

Sheep Street loading and unloading area - 9 blue badge spaces

Windsor Street – 8 blue badge spaces

Southern Lane – (rear of The Other Place) 10 blue badge spaces

Blue badge users should check signage to see if there is a time limit or required to pay for their parking.
