1	10:10 am	The Mayor and Consort, Town Clerk, Beadle, Macebearers and Mayor's Cadet, Sword Bearer/Escorts arrive at the Town Hall to robe.
2	10:10 am	Town Councillors arrive at the Town Hall to robe. Past Mayor's, Mayoresses and Consorts and other guests arrive by 10:25am at the latest.
3	10:35 am	The Civic Party will move off from the Town Hall, escorted by the ATC Marching Band, via Chapel Street, Church Street and Old Town directly to the Garden of Remembrance in the following order: <p style="text-align: center;">Beadle Ludford & Sadler Macebearers The Mayor and the Lord Lieutenant Rep. 4	10:45 am	The Mayor, accompanied by the Civic party enter the Garden of Remembrance to take up position facing the WW2 memorial.
5	10:50am	The service begins.
6	11.00am	"Two Minutes Silence", Last Post, Reveille and Wreath Laying Ceremony <p style="text-align: center;"><u>IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT ONLY THE MAYOR AND MALE MEMBERS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL ARE TO REMOVE THEIR HATS DURING THE PLAYING OF LAST POST AND THE TWO MINUTES SILENCE. The Mayor will lay wreaths on the 1914-18 and 1939-45 War memorials.</u></p>
7	11.15am	At the conclusion of the Wreath Laying Ceremony and Act of Commitment, the National Anthem will be played, and the standards dipped.
8	11:17am	The Clergy and choir leave the Garden through the Old Town Gate
9	11:20am	The Civic Party will leave the Garden through the College Street Gate and recess unaccompanied directly to the saluting dais in Church Street for the March Past and Salute, via Old Town.

10	11:30am	<p>The Contingents will leave the garden by the Old Town Gate and form up in Southern Lane. The ATC band will lead the contingents via Southern Lane, Waterside and Chapel Lane to Church Street, where the Dais will be situated opposite Elizabeth House for the March Past and Salute, taken by the Mayor and senior military officer present. The Parade returns to Bull Street</p> <p><u>During the March Past, the Mayor will take the salute and should remove his/her hat.</u></p>
11	11:50am	<p>Following the March Past, the Mayor, Councillors and guests return to the Town Hall for coffee/um.</p>
