1 Colin Stewart, Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and Imogen Suett a Student working with RB at SDC.

Apologies: George Cowcher, Andy List, Mark Haselden, Stephen Rumble, Jann Tracy.

- **2** Minutes: of 13 July 2023 were approved.
- 3 Actions and Matters arising: CS noted that once again there was no representative officer from WCC at the meeting and said that he would enquire how this could be resolved.
 KR spoke about the changes to resident parking permits; their application which had been moved to online and method to obtain visitor permits, which was causing concern and difficulties. Changes were being made for better access, JM has oversight of this, and was meeting County representatives on 11 August to review.
- 4 Canal Towpaths: LM reported on the poor condition of the towpaths, particularly Birmingham road to Bishopton, and that he had contacted the Canal & River Trust to see what could be done to improve them. He thought that locally we should be contributing towards this. New homes were being sold that it was possible to walk along the towpaths to town, but it was not

possible for all users. **CS** concurred that the condition of the section between Timothys Bridge Rd, and Bishopton Lane was particularly poor as this is only a gravel surface, and there are low hanging branches which require bending down to pass. He noted it is Cycle Route 5, and also now advertised as the "Park n Stride" route into the town, from the Park & Ride Site. **LM** will chase the Canal & River Trust to see what can be done. **RB** will check whether there is any requirement under Section 106 for the Bishopton Houses developer to upgrade the towpath.

5 Demand Responsive Transport [DRT]: After seeing the new IndieGo Plus app advertised. CS had investigated DRT (Demand Responsive Transport) in the county and noted Stratford is separate.

IndieGo is a joint venture between Warwickshire County Council, Stagecoach & Liftango. So, is part of the bus network, that covers most of Warwickshire, with consistent branding and web site for all the routes, covering Rugby, Warwick, Leamington, Kenilworth...

UBUS is totally separate, run by SDC, and part funded by WCC. With a totally different name and branding.

He noted that if you search on Google for "On Demand Bus in Warwickshire", the rest of Warwickshire services come up, but Stratford or UBUS doesn't!

He referred to a presentation about DRT that WCC Stuart Kocan Payne had made earlier this year to the WCC, Town & Parish Reference Group. There was only one page for UBUS out of 20, with no detail, and no statistical reporting.

CS suggested bringing UBUS under the IndieGo banner, rebranding the buses, and consequently benefiting from all that WCC do to promote it, and allow people to access it, such as the online App. TTG members agreed. JM noted that the app is currently a pilot, but appears to be working well. He agreed to look into the potential to bring UBUS and IndieGo together.

- **6.5** Bus Strategy: At the last meeting ED had asked that wording was changed on the WCC Park & Stride website to explain that the towpaths were not for everyone. It's not happened yet but David Ayton-Hill WCC was getting a change done.

- **8 Planning Applications:** An application for 60 dwellings and access at Airfield House, Long Marston, was noted and the further potential to add congestion to the town's roads without a solution.
 - The plan to enlarge the High School to 12 form entry was noted, again no indication of transport improvements.
- 9 Any Other Business: KR talked about a 1-year trial of EV charging points via lampposts in Chestnut Walk. ED has concerns about access to public EV charging points as many cannot be reached [Chestnut Walk] and will contact appropriate WCC officers.
