**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(WATERSIDE AND SHEEP STREET, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON)**  
**(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC)**  
**(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2018**

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the Twenty-Ninth day of October 2018 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Waterside and Sheep Street, Stratford-upon-Avon) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and One Way Traffic) (Experimental) Order 2018".
2. In this Order:-  
  
"motor vehicle" has the same meanings as in section 136 of the Act; and  
  
"the 2016 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or with the prior written authority of Warwickshire County Council, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in that length of Waterside, Stratford upon Avon which extends between its junctions with Sheep Street and Chapel Lane, for a period of 18 months commencing on the Twenty-Ninth day of October 2018.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to therein if the motor vehicle:-
  - (1) is being used in connection with the carrying out on that length of road of any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
    - (ii) maintenance, improvement, repair or reconstruction work, and the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in that length of road of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - (2) is being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (3) is being used in the service of a local authority or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker or the Environment Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties which are being undertaken on that length of road; or

- (4) is being used by, or on behalf of, The Royal Shakespeare Company in connection with The Royal Shakespeare Theatre which is situate adjacent to the length of road referred to therein.
5. The Council is satisfied that for the purposes of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the length of road referred to in Article 3 above, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, it is requisite that section 3(1) of the Act should not apply to this Experimental Order.
  6. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Sheep Street, Stratford upon Avon which extends from its junction with Waterside, westwards for a distance of 115 metres, otherwise than in a westerly direction for a period of 18 months commencing on the Twenty-Ninth day of October 2018.
  7. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle.
  8. A Managing Director of Warwickshire County Council may, if it appears to him or her essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Experimental Order runs, after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police, may modify or suspend the operation of this Experimental Order or any provision hereof.
