

**ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE
TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847
FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION IN STREETS**

**ROAD CLOSURE ORDER NUMBER NO. 30 - 2018
WATERSIDE SUNDAY AND BANK HOLIDAY MONDAY MARKETS
Sunday 1st April – Sunday 23rd December 2018**


During certain hours on Sunday 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th April, 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th May, 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th June, 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th July, 5th, 12th, 19th, 26th August, 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th September, 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th October, 4th, 11th, 18th, 25th November, 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd December 2018 and Monday 2nd April, 7th, 28th May, 27th August 2018, Waterside from Bridge Street to Sheep Street, Stratford upon Avon ("the Streets"), will be thronged or liable to be obstructed on the occasion of the Waterside Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday Markets.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, Stratford-on-Avon District Council of Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon aforesaid do HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the Streets on the said day the following Regulations shall be observed:-

1. Save as provided in Regulations 2 and 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive, ride or propel any vehicle, or cause or permit any vehicle to wait on or in the Streets between 04:00 hours to 21:00 hours on each of the Sundays, and Bank Holiday Mondays listed above.
2. Nothing in the Regulation 1 of this Order shall apply to any vehicles being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes in the exercise of statutory powers or duties.
3. Any person directed or permitted by a police constable in uniform to drive, ride or propel or to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on or in the Streets during the said hours on the said day shall comply with the direction of the police constable and of any other police constable in uniform.
4. All persons present in the Streets during the said hours on the said day shall comply with the directions of any police constable in uniform.
5. Willful breach of this Order is an offence and any person committing such an offence shall be liable to a fine not exceeding One Thousand pounds.
